

How to...

Get RM98 working under Vista

RaceMaster98 was written in a more innocent age and writes to parts of the disc and the Windows registry which are not allowed by the Vista User Account Control (UAC) system. The answer is to turn UAC off.

How to turn Windows Vista User Account Control off:

- Open the Windows Control Panel.
- Open the User Accounts applet.
- Select Turn 'User Account Control on or off'.
- Un-tick the box marked 'Use User Account Control (UAC) to help protect your computer'.
- Press the OK button.
- You will be prompted to restart your computer.

After your computer has restarted RaceMaster98 should work OK but you may need to uninstall it and then re-install.

You may get warnings from Windows telling you that your computer is insecure. This can be stopped by changing the 'Change how windows alerts me' setting in the Security Centre.
